

The Branch Office in Thailand of Tokyo SME Support Center Opens -In Bangkok, It Aims to Support Business Development of Tokyo-Based SMEs -

Tokyo Government, in tie-ups with Tokyo SME Support Center (a public interest incorporated foundation, hereinafter call the "Center"), has been engaged in the development and expansion of overseas sales for Tokyo-based SMEs.

For the purpose of further enhancement of the supporting activities, the Center will open the first overseas office in Bangkok, Thailand, where is located in the center of ASEAN and with high market needs. The office will start its activities on December 21st, 2015 and support on-site business development for Tokyo-based SMEs, in cooperation with Thai Ministry of Industry, Kasikornbank, and the Bangkok branch of Tokyo Metropolitan Industrial Technology Research Institute, and promote the extension of business networks with and among ASEAN countries, starting with Thailand.
