


Metro Houston Employment




COST OF LIVING COMPARISON



CTMC, the Cell Therapy Manufacturing Center, is a joint venture between **National Resilience** and **MD Anderson Cancer Center**. Located in the Texas Medical Center, CTMC's physical proximity to MD Anderson facilitates collaboration with its expert network of researchers, leverages its robust clinical trial infrastructure, and brings novel, groundbreaking therapies closer to patients. Within the last 18 months, CTMC filed and received approval for **6 INDs** without delay and currently has **8 therapies in clinical trials**.






